Thanks to you, we are continuing the ministry to children, and thanks to your support, we can not only minister to them, but also give the kids Christmas gifts. For them, this is a great joy and blessing. So, we are forwarding to you these children's greetings and gratitude!

We visited the orphanage in Kopylov. There, in the past several months, the leadership has changed, including the director. They're already on their third

director for the year, and some of their staff members have changed too. At this orphanage, we often need to stop and get acquainted with the new leadership. The children constantly change. Some kids get adopted by families; others get sent to different children's homes. It's hard to hold lessons for the kids, because the constant turnover. Over the course of six months, one hundred percent of the children have changed. There's a team of Christian teachers who regularly go to this children's home. We fill in for them when they can't go, or else we hold a separate program for the children.

We arrived with the puppet theater and your gifts. At the current time, the kids in this home are very difficult. It's hard to capture their attention. They're always getting distracted and running around. The staff can't do anything with them. They say that, in the entire history of this children's home, these are the very hardest children to work with. During the show, two girls even broke into a fight. After the presentation, sister Ludmila walked over to one of these girls and got acquainted with her. The girl's name is Liza. Ludmila managed to draw Liza into a conversation. Liza shared her life's story, about how she does have parents, but they hardly pay her any attention and she

isn't receiving parental warmth and care. She is very hurt and angry at her parents. By the end of their conversation, Liza had tears in her eyes and accepted Jesus as her Savior. Praise the Lord! Now Ludmila visits Liza and is mentoring her in the faith. Please pray for Liza and for the other children in this home, that they will be saved.
