During this time that is so difficult for all of us, the Lord is continuing His work here on Earth. Praise be to Him! Here is a little about the life of our church... Here in Lviv, it's difficult to work with people, because they consider themselves genuine Christians but regard us as a cult group. However, this has become a bit easier. Pray for us! We are exerting all our efforts to bring new people to Christ.

God is blessing our Bible study group. There are new people who have repented and desire to be baptized. Hallelujah! This is our goal. My relatives also came to be with us for the holiday. They joined the church for a dinner. Praise the Lord, we are continuing the work with children, teens, and youth.
