

We started experiencing emergency power cuts. Sometimes there is no electricity for a whole day, and sometimes for 12 or more hours. Basically, for 4 hours there is light, and for 4 hours there isn't. That's a typical a schedule. And so on, day after day. But there is always a way out. We thank you, dear friends, for taking care of us and helping us buy a charging station, which helps us a lot. We use it in the service and for the

puppet theater. Very often, we do not have

electricity at services. That is especially inconvenient in the evening, when it's already dark outside. But thanks to this station, we always have light, even if only partially.

We were very blessed that on Christmas Day we had power all day. We had a great day, a great service, and a great fellowship after the service. A cozy, family atmosphere reigned at the service. Everyone felt happy and complete peace

and tranquility. And we were not hit with rockets that day! Thank God!
